**1** **Review the privacy policies and terms of use of websites and applications, and be certain that you have control over what you share and who can see it. Do not ignore the small print.**

**2** **To protect your account, make sure you use strong passwords and avoid using passwords that can be easily guessed by hackers.**

**3** Enable two-factor authentication on your online accounts and devices. Double authentication for account access is strongly advised.

**4** Be mindful of how much information you disclose online. Think twice before disclosing personal or sensitive information on social media platforms.

**5** **Be cautious about sharing your location, personal details, or travel plans publicly.**

**6** **Regularly update your apps. Keep your social media apps up to date to benefit from the latest security features.**

**Beware of phishing attempts by online fraudsters. Be vigilant against suspicious messages or links from unknown persons trying to gain access to your personal information or login to your account.**
